Just a kind reminder

Immunising your child is a safe and important way to protect them from diseases. Once your child has been vaccinated against a disease, their body can fight it off better. When children are not vaccinated, they are at higher risk of catching, and becoming very ill, from the disease.

If you are unsure about whether your child has had all their routine immunisations, contact us, or book a Nurse's appointment to find out.

Just a kind reminder

NHS cervical screening helps prevent cervical cancer. Cervical screening is for women and people with a cervix. We offer screening every 3 years from age 25 to 49 and every 5 years from age 50 to 64. This is because most cervical cancers develop between these ages. First invitations arrive a few months before people turn 25.

You can book your appointment as soon as you get your invitation.
